Substituting for a Human Services Required Elective(s)

Effective Fall 2016

- A student may substitute five credits of one 300- or 400-level class from another department (including a language class being used as part of a Minor) for a Human Services elective, with faculty advisor approval.
- A student wishing to substitute more than five credits total of Human Services electives should meet with their Human Services faculty advisor and provide a rationale (no more than one page) describing how the course package would contribute to their Human Services education.
