

**Adult and Higher Education MEd Candidates
Admissions Summary**

Admission to the MEd in Adult and Higher Education program requires a minimum grade point average of 3.0 and presentation of GRE or Miller Analogies Test scores. While the program does not have minimum score requirements, admission decisions are made within the context of test scores and grade point average. The table below shows the mean GRE and MAT scores of the candidates enrolled in the MEd in Education Administration program during successive fall terms. Items for which there are less than 5 scores are not reported here.
