

**MA in Rehabilitation Counseling  
Admissions Summary**

Admission to the MA in Rehabilitation Counseling program requires a minimum grade point average of 3.0 and presentation of GRE or MAT test scores. While the program does not have minimum test score requirements, admission decisions are made within the context of test scores and grade point average. The table below shows the mean GRE and MAT scores of the candidates enrolled in the MA in Rehabilitation Counseling during fall terms. Items for which there are less than 5 scores reported are not reported here.
