

**MA in Rehabilitation Counseling  
Program-Level Assessments 2007 - 2015**

The rehabilitation counseling program at Western Washington University has an assessment plan to measure candidate knowledge and skills relative to institutional, state and national standards. The assessment plan also yields data on which to base continuous program improvement. The plan includes assessments used at each of four decision points in the program: application; continuation; qualification for internship and program completion. To qualify for internship, students must achieve a grade of B or better in RC 583, Practice of Rehabilitation Counseling, and successfully pass RC 591, Practicum in Rehabilitation Counseling.
