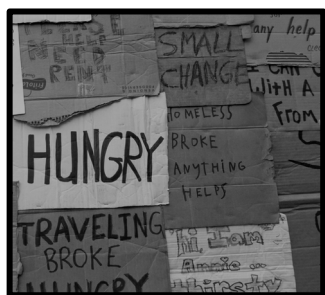


Imagine you lost everything.

Volunteer Tutor Position Description:

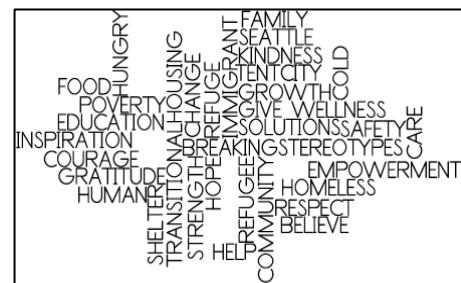
Position consists of 3-months (12 weeks) of tutoring a LiHi resident

Volunteer Tutoring Session Logistics:

- Each week, volunteers will tutor residents for 1-1.5 hours.
- Tutoring sessions will occur at a public place of convenience, such as libraries, or at a community center at LiHi in Seattle.

LiHi Volunteer Training:

LiHi will provide volunteer tutors with an orientation.
