 Fall 2015 - Summer 2016 Teacher Education Applicant Data

Woodring teacher education programs received a total of 614 applications to enter in the year 2015-2016. Sixty-three percent of the applicants were offered admission and 55% accepted the offer and entered Woodring programs.
