

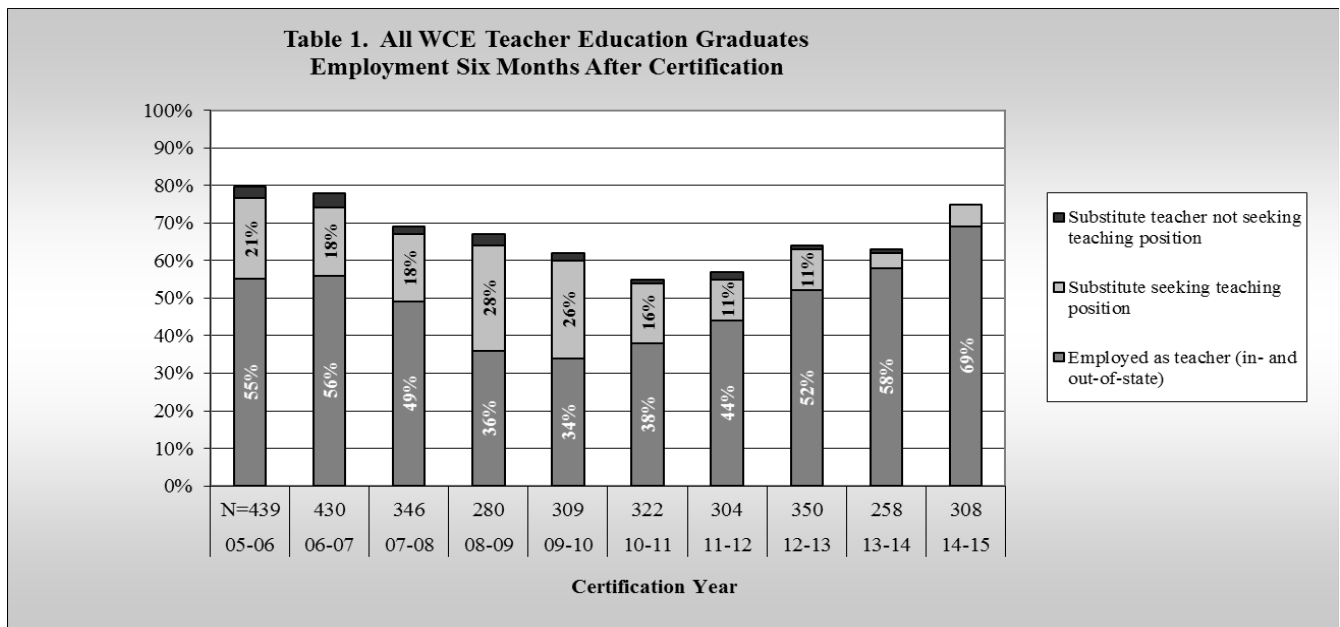


**Woodring College of Education
Fall 2005 through Spring 2015 Teacher Education Graduates
Longitudinal View of Placement Data**

The Career Services Center of Western Washington University conducts a survey each year on the employment status of the previous year's graduates. The Career Center has provided Woodring College of Education the raw data on the teacher education graduates for a more detailed analysis against WCE program and student data. This report presents ten years of placement data on WCE teacher education graduates.

The response rate for the placement survey remains very high at 83% for the 2014-2015 graduates.

Table 1 displays teacher education graduates employed as teachers three to six months after certification.

Table 2 displays the proportion of teaching positions obtained in Washington State vs. those obtained in other states over the ten-year period.

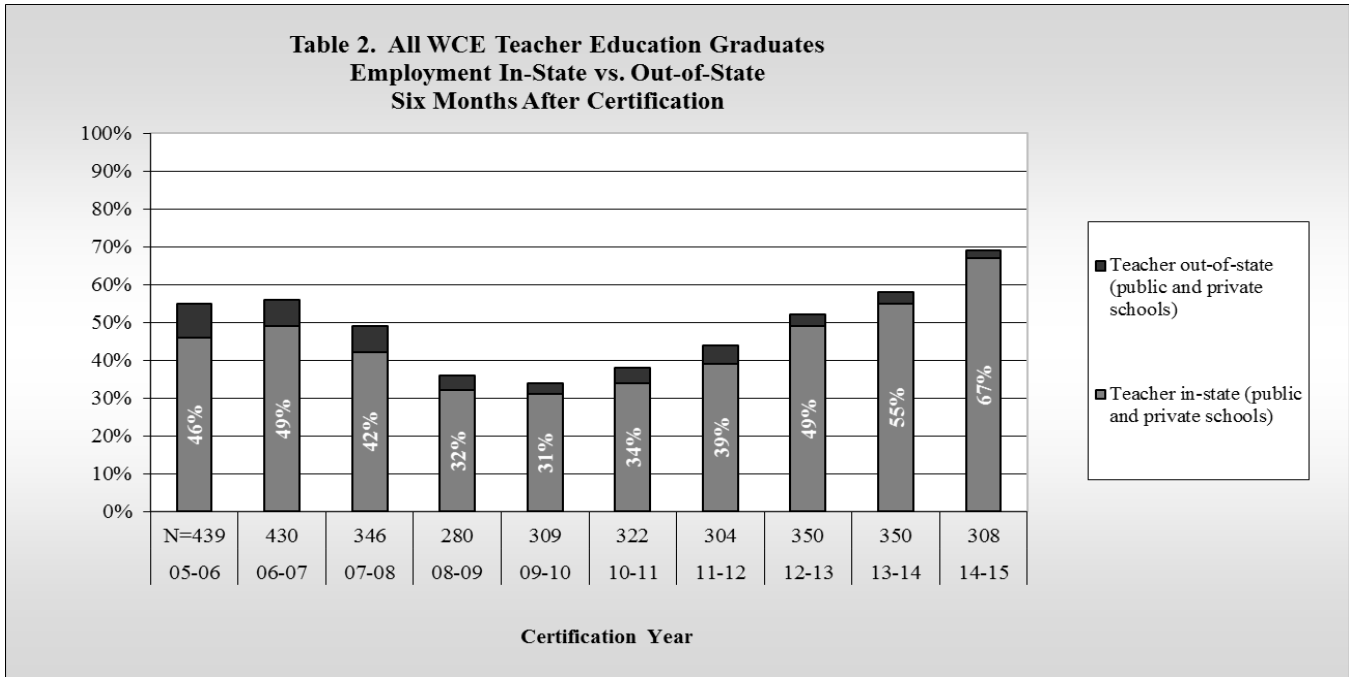
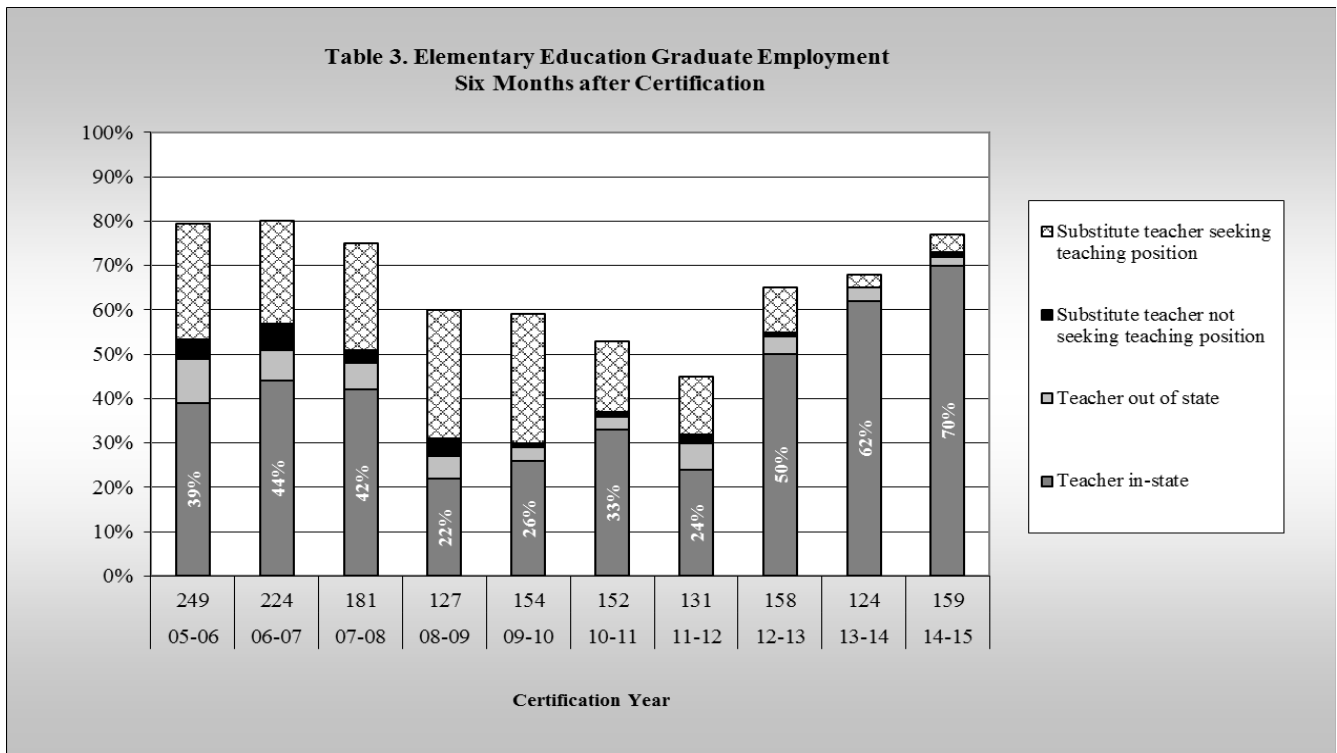
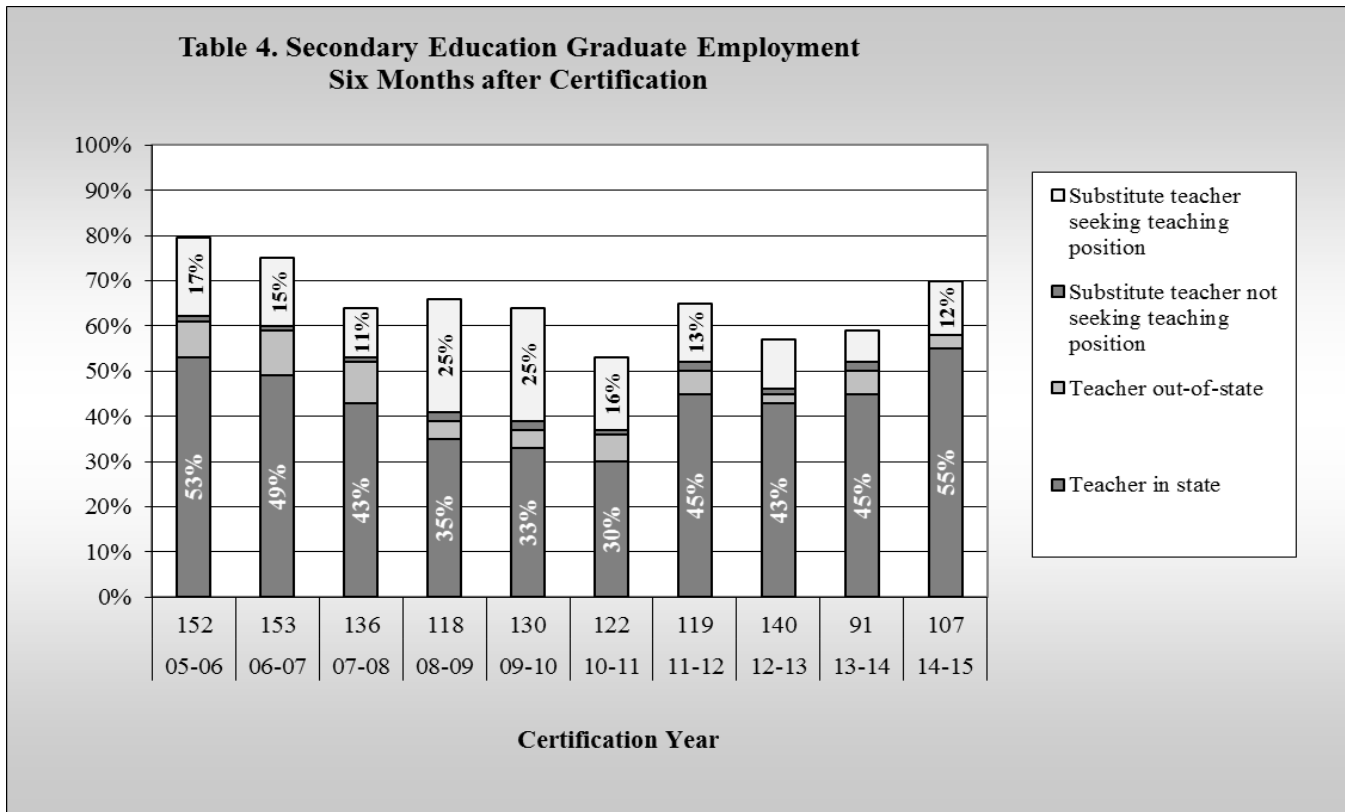


Table 3 shows the percentage of Elementary Education, Early Childhood Education and Skagit Alternate Route program graduates who were employed as teachers six months after completion over the ten-year period.

The undergraduate, post-baccalaureate and MIT Secondary program graduates who were teaching six months post-certification are combined in Table 4.



The Special Education graduates who were employed as teachers six months after graduation are displayed in Table 5. These data include graduates of the Early Childhood Special Education, the Special Education and the combined Special and Elementary Education programs.
