DTA/GUR completion	<b>Washington State Employee Tuition Waiver</b>  <i>See individual colleges for specific information</i>	Tuition waived for eligible courses (course and waiver fees still apply)  <i>See individual college policies and requirements</i>	For Washington State employees.
